

Terms & Conditions

Registration Terms, Conditions and Waivers

1. Payments, Cancellations and Discounts
 - a. A non-refundable deposit of \$75 will be charged for each registration. Our registration system will indicate the amount of the session deposit. Without this deposit, your registration is not reserved.
 - b. Payments on camping sessions or programs can be made with a credit card through your online account.
 - c. Camp tuition, in full, as well as the Inclusion Assessment, Health History, and Success Contract are due two weeks prior to the start of your camp session unless otherwise stated during the registration process. Camp Fire Inland Northwest reserves the right to auto-charge the debit/credit card on file as indicated on my tuition contract.
 - d. Any discounts offered will be detailed on our registration site.
 - e. Changes to a different program or session may take place at any time with no fee, except for the difference in program cost.
 - i. Changes are subject to program or session availability.
 - ii. All changes must be requested by calling the office at 509-747-6191.
 - f. Cancellation and Refund Policy: Camp Fire Inland Northwest reserves the right to cancel any camping session or program, for any reason.
 - i. If Camp Fire must cancel a camping session or program due to low enrollment or for any other reason, a full refund will be issued if we cannot place your camper in an alternative program.
 - ii. If you need to cancel your registration, you must call the office at 509-747-6191.
 - iii. For cancellations more than two weeks prior to the start of your session, the deposit is non-refundable however additional payments made will be refunded. For cancellations within two weeks of the start of your session, neither the deposit, nor any additional payments will be refundable.
 - iv. In the event of a medical condition that causes cancellation, a full refund minus deposit will be given if we cannot move the camper into another camping session or program. Written notification from a physician is required. Payments may be transferable to a sibling or another Camp Fire camping session or program within the same season.
 - v. If the Health History, Inclusion Assessment, and Success Contract are not received two weeks prior to the start of the program the Camper will not be permitted to attend camp and neither the deposit, nor any additional payments will be refundable.
 - vi. If a camper leaves camp early due to illness or injury, the camp tuition may be refunded at a pro-rated rate, or the camper may be able to attend a later session.
 - vii. If a camper leaves camp early or arrives late due to homesickness, behavior problems, or for any other reason, there will be no refund or pro-rated fees. Transportation for late arrivals and early pick-ups are entirely the primary account holder's responsibility.
2. Release and Waiver
 - a. I agree to release, indemnify, and hold Camp Fire Inland Northwest, its agents, officers, and employees harmless from any and all liability claims, actions, judgments, damages or injuries of any kind and nature whatsoever to the participant and/or his/her/their property arising from participation in activities for which he/she/they is registering.
 - b. I further acknowledge that I have familiarized myself with the description of the activities, understand the hazards and participant's personal limitations and knowingly assume all risks.

- c. I attest that my Camper(s) is/are in good health and able to participate actively in all activities except as noted in their Health History.
- d. I authorize staff to provide routine health care, administer prescribed and over-the-counter medications that I am sending with my Camper(s), as well as any medications recommended by the on-call nurse for various problems except as I have noted on the Health History form. I further acknowledge that it is my responsibility to ensure any necessary medications for my Camper are present at camp. If I fail to provide necessary medication for my Camper, I will make arrangements to deliver medications directly to camp healthcare staff. I acknowledge that mailing medications, leaving them at the Camp Fire Office in Spokane for transport, and other means whereby camp staff, other than healthcare staff, are requested to handle medications is prohibited. I authorize Camp Fire Inland Northwest to share information provided with selected staff (counselor, health care, food service, etc.) and professional health care providers on a need-to-know basis.
- e. I understand that all reasonable measures have been taken to safeguard the health and safety of all participants and that I will be notified as soon as possible in case of an emergency affecting the participant. In the event of illness or emergency, I authorize the Camp Director or appropriate staff to place my Camper under the care of a physician and notify me at once. I agree to the release of any records necessary for treatment, referral, billing, or insurance purposes.
- f. I acknowledge that Camp Fire Inland Northwest, its agents, officers, and employees, are not liable for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
- g. I understand the registration, refund procedures and other details in the camp brochure or on the website pertaining to participation.
